
## Art Activities Headdress and Mask




Draw out your  
headband.

A straight line with a  
bump in the middle!



Cut out  
carefully with a  
pair of blunt  
ended scissors.



Join the two ends together and secure with sticky tape.




Now you're ready to decorate your headdress with paints or coloured paper.




I glued on  
some old  
Christmas  
wrapping  
paper to cover  
this headdress.



Now it is ready  
for some paper  
feathers.  
Use real  
feathers if you  
have some  
available.



Cut out this  
shape from  
some drawing  
paper.



Draw in your feather shapes and then cut around the top edges. Colour your feathers with paint or colour pencils.



Now your  
feathers are  
ready to attach  
to the top of  
your  
headdress.



I used sticky  
tape to secure  
my paper  
feathers.



Now your  
carnival  
headdress is  
ready to wear!  
You can add  
some more  
decoration if  
you want.

I've cut out some round shapes from glittery Christmas wrapping paper and glued them on.



Join the  
Armidale  
Parade!

Mask making.



Using the templates provided, trace out your chosen design onto cardboard or a stiff piece of paper.

Then cut out carefully with scissors.



Decorate with  
paint, crayon  
or colour  
pencil.




Cut out some interesting shapes from gift wrapping paper, or use whatever decorative materials you may already have.

I've glued on shapes cut out from Christmas wrapping paper, as well as some beads and glittery stars from my art box.



Wind some glittery ribbon around a wooden barbecue stick and then, using sticky tape, secure it to the side of your carnival mask.



Now your mask is finished.
