
Instructions



- 1. Print the template sheet on an A4 sheet of card.
- 2. Colour the bookmark base and the parts of the monkey.
- 3. Cut out all of the pieces and cut an extra piece of card the same size as the bookmark base. Curl the end of pipecleaner.

Silvery Langur: also known as the silvered leaf monkey or the silver lutung, lives in the trees of Johur. They have grey-tipped, dark brown or black fur, giving them a silvery appearance. Their infants are born orange in colour.







- 4. Glue a small part of the ears to the back of the head making sure the coloured side faces the front.
- 5. Glue a small part of the arms and legs to the back of the base making sure the coloured side faces the front. Glue the hands to the front of the base.
- 6. Stick the curled tail to the back of the base with adhesive tape.



- **7.** Glue the head at the top of the bookmark so the chin covers the front of the card.
- **8.** Once all the parts are fixed, glue the separate piece of cut card to the back of the base to finish.
