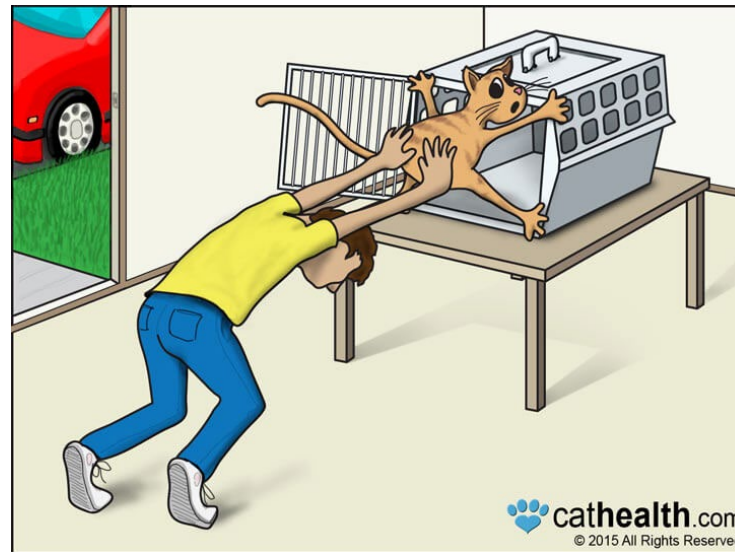

Can you guess what reluctant means?



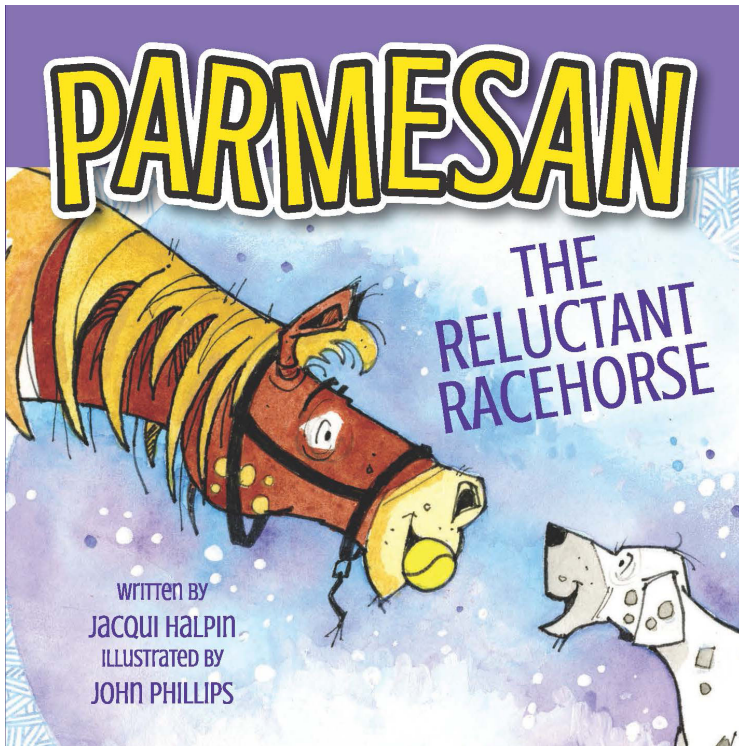
